

BY-LAWS OF RECLAMATION DISTRICT NO 2084

We, the undersigned, being the sole owners and all the owners of lands embraced within Reclamation District No. 2084 do hereby adopt the following as the By-Laws of said District:

ARTICLE I

- Section 1. The office of Reclamation District No. 2084 shall be at 507 Main St., Rio Vista, County of Solano, State of California.
- Section 2. The regular meetings of the Board of Trustees shall be held on the last Wednesday in each month.
- Section 3. Special meetings shall be called by the President by giving one day's notice in writing to the members of the Board of Trustees.

ARTICLE II

- Section 1. The officers of the District shall consist of a President and Secretary.
- Section 2. The duties of the President shall be to preside at all meetings of the Board of Trustees, to sign all contracts when authorized by the Board of Trustees, and to perform such other duties as from time to time may be required of him by the Board.
- Section 3. It shall be the duty of the Secretary to keep the records of the proceedings of the Board of Trustees, to keep an account of all receipts and expenditures made by the District, and to perform such other duties as may be required of him by the Board.
- Section 4. A majority of the Board of Trustees shall constitute a quorum for the transaction of business.
